PROGRAM

Enjoy four weeks in beautiful Valparaíso, Chile, while you learn on the campus of Universidad Católica de Valparaíso. The program will include a language course and a content course, both taught entirely in Spanish by WSU and UCV Instructors. Students will improve their oral skills as well as their written Spanish and reading abilities. The program will include extra-academic activities, such as city tours and visits to handcraft workshops.

Students will participate in two cultural excursions. One to Santiago "the route of wine" (Casablanca Valley), and the other to Isla Negra, where one of the poet Pablo Neruda's unusual houses is located. Students will learn about Chilean society, the way Chilean people live, their culture, holidays, music, typical cuisine, and family life.
