

Non-WSU Applicants: How to Apply for a WSU Education Abroad Program

Individuals interested in applying for a WSU education abroad program, including Faculty-led, Partnership, or Exchange programs must go through the process outlined below. All participants must apply to WSU and enroll in the credits associated with the education abroad program. Non-WSU students must apply to WSU as a Non-Degree Seeking student. Non-WSU students can utilize WSU's education abroad search engine, however to apply for a program requires several extra steps that must be initiated before an application for the education abroad program can be started.

1. Apply to WSU as a Non-Degree Seeking student

- a. This must be initiated **at least 2 weeks prior** to the education abroad programs application deadline.
- b. \$25 fee will apply, link to apply: <https://www.applyweb.com/wsunivnd/>

2. Create your NID: Once your Non-Degree Seeking application has been processed you will receive an email with your Temporary Access Network Key (TANK) with the subject line "Important! Create your WSU Network ID (NID)" (example email on page 2)

- a. Follow the steps in this email to setup your NID
- b. This will give you a Student Account at WSU which you will be billed through

3. Next, create your WSU username and password

- a. It is possible to do this when setting up your NID, however it is easiest to call the WSU IT Help Desk to get this setup.

 - ii. Tell them you just applied and received your Temporary Access Network Key and are trying to get your username and password set up. Ask them if they can help you identify what your username and password is, or how to set that up.
- b. After you have created your WSU username and password it will take at least 24 hours before you can use it in the WSU system.

4. Now you can apply to the WSU education abroad program!


- a. Use the "Apply Now" link on the programs flyer or search for the program using [this link](#).
- b. Pay close attention to the application deadline listed for the program. You must have all items completed by 5pm on the deadline day.
